

BOARD VOTING

Decisions approved by a majority of a quorum of the board, acting in a legal meeting of the board, shall be considered legal board decisions. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the board.

Votes on all motions and resolutions shall be by "yes" or "no". A member may abstain from voting. Abstains shall not be counted as either "yes" or "no" votes. In order for a motion to pass, "yes" votes must be more than "no" votes. No secret ballot shall be used.

Members shall vote individually, by voice vote, and the votes of the members shall be individually recorded.

Each member and officer shall have one vote. All motions shall be carried by a majority of the members present and voting, provided a quorum is present. A majority shall mean "more than half" of the votes cast.
